

SERGER CAMP at THE WILD ROSE!

You are invited to join Camp Leader Nadeen Ward for a weekend of fun and adventures while learning various techniques on your serger! Camp begins on Saturday, January 23 at 9am with what else, snacks! Your first class begins at 9:30-10:30 and you'll use your serger in 4-thread mode to make a gift bag. You'll learn to serge in a circle on this project! Kit fee: \$10.

Your next camp project begins at 11 and ends at 1:30. You'll learn to put in a zipper with your serger! You finish the bag using your serger and make a rolled hem tassel to finish it off. You'll use decorative thread to show off your rolled hem. Kit fee: \$5.

At 2:30-5pm, you'll use a heavier weight thread and put crochet lace on a tea towel as well as learn to make a carnation from thread! You can experiment with different weight thread as well as mix colors or try variegated thread. Kit fee: \$10.

Sunday's camp project begins at 10:30 with Sunday Snacks. Class begins at 11 and ends at 1:30 and is called "Ruffles and More." You'll make a ruffled edge pillowcase and a small tiered skirt with your serger's gathering foot. Kit fee \$10.

Afternoon camp brings you Serger Heirloom. You'll make pintucks, rouching and learn to create heirloom fabric by inserting lace and entredeux. Your project is to make a neck roll pillow with your newfound skills in this session. This session is from 2:30-5. Kit fee: \$10
